The division of tasks and work is organised as follows:

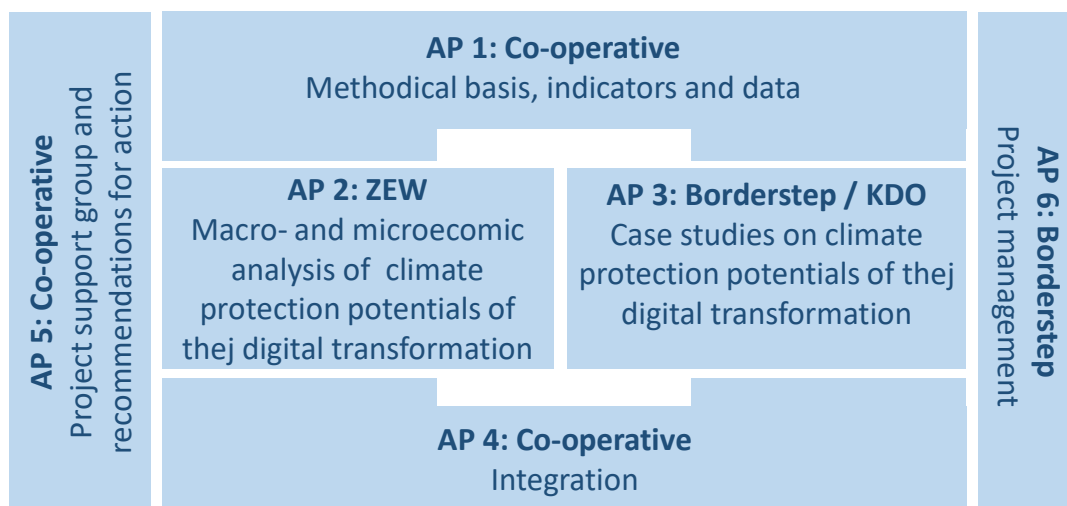
WP 1: Joint methodological work of Borderstep and ZEW
